## Programme on Social Impact Assessment (April 26-28, 2017)

### Background

Social Impact Assessment (SIA) is the process of assessing, in advance, the social impacts likely to follow from a project. SIA is a powerful tool allowing decision makers to initiate steps necessary to prevent/contain harmful potential impacts of proposed projects. SIA is also an entry point for initiating consultation with the affected communities and other stakeholders. This consultation process gives early warning signals about the negative impacts of the project and helps address genuine issues and grievances faced by the local communities. The consultation process also reduces the risks associated with the project by minimizing conflicts and disputes over impacts and mitigation.

SIA has now become an integral part of the project preparation process. **The Right to Fair Compensation and Transparency in Land Acquisition, Rehabilitation and Resettlement (RFCTLARR) Act, 2013** that replaced the colonial Land Acquisition Act (LAA), 1894 requires the conduct of a mandatory SIA Study prior to initiation of land acquisition. The legislation also specifies an elaborate process for the conduct of the SIA study and its subsequent evaluation through Expert Group.

### Programme Objectives

How can we ensure that SIA becomes a powerful decision making tool as conceptualised by the new land acquisition Act. Within the mandated timeline, what should we do to ensure that the SIA Study does complete justice to its laudable objectives? How can SIA surveys be made more accurate and effective? How should SIA Study be monitored? There is a need for comprehensive understanding of the processes and due diligence measures for an impactful SIA Study. It is with this prerogative that the Centre for Excellence in Management of LARR (CMLARR), ASCI is organising our much appreciated Annual Program on LARR. **The Centre has developed software applications that will enable hassle free and accurate surveys and templates for effectively conducting and monitoring such studies.** The Centre has also prepared a comprehensive manual on LARR covering detailed step-wise procedures for SIA, LA and R & R in line with the RFCTLARR Act.

The key objectives of the programme are:

- To develop an understanding of the legislative framework governing SIA in the country.
- To develop an understanding of the types of social impacts in diverse development projects, tools and techniques for predicting these social impacts and developing appropriate mitigation plans.
- To provide an in-depth understanding of measures to effectively conduct and monitor the SIA study as envisaged under the RFCTLARR Act, 2013.

### About CMLARR, ASCI

Established with the support of the World Bank and AusAID, CMLARR has been leading the capacity building interventions for LARR specialist officers in India and in the South Asian region. The Centre has been engaged in supporting the Department of Land Resources, Government of India as well as various state governments in the implementation of the RFCTLARR Act, 2013.. The Centre has conducted customised capacity building programs on the RFCTLARR Act, 2013 for the Governments of Karnataka, Bihar, Tamil Nadu, Punjab and Sikkim. Dealing officers from 20 state governments have also participated in the LARR Courses at ASCI. The Centre has also prepared a comprehensive Courseware on LARR, covering detailed step-wise procedures for LA and R & R in line with the RFCTLARR Act, 2013. The Centre has been involved extensively in

capacity building interventions on "Improved Management of Land Acquisition, Resettlement & Rehabilitation (MLARR)" for Senior IAS Officers, World Bank supported Projects, ADB supported Projects, Government organisations and several public/private sector organizations in the country.

CMLARR is conducting Joint Certification Programs in LARR partnering the National Research Centre for Resettlement (NRRCR), Hohai University, China. Other prominent international assignments of the Centre include customized module for "Formulating a National Resettlement Policy and Improved Management of LARR" for the Ministerial delegation from Government of Uganda and Egypt; international programs/workshops on R & R and Benefit Sharing, advisory guidance to University of Peradeniya, Sri-Lanka in improving their LARR Course, support for various Training of Trainers Workshops organized by World Bank for South Asian countries etc.

#### **Participant Profile**

State government officials in charge of Land Acquisition and SIA; Executives working in Public and Private Sector Organisations in land acquisition, R & R, environment, CSR and R & R departments.

#### **Training Methods**

This 3-day intensive program places emphasis on interactive learning. The highly interactive learning environment combines experience sharing, case studies, role play exercises and lectures cum-discussion. The mix of the methods aims to provide ample opportunity to the participants to learn from the peer group as well as faculty and subject experts.

#### **Venue**

The Programme is fully residential and the participants will be accommodated in single air-conditioned rooms in the Bellavista/College Park Campus of the College. The College does not provide accommodation for the family. Transport between Airport / Railway Station and Campus will be arranged by the College. The College campus is WiFi enabled.

#### **Duration**

The Programme duration is from Wednesday, **26<sup>th</sup> April, 2017** to Friday, **28<sup>th</sup> April, 2017**. The participants are expected to arrive a day before the commencement and may leave after the conclusion of the programme.

#### **Programme Fee**

**Rs. 34,000/-** (US\$1495 if foreign) plus 15% Service Tax per participant (will be charged to cover tuition, board and lodging, courseware (in electronic form) and other facilities of the College including Internet usage.

**Rs.28,000/-** plus 15% Service Tax for Indian participants not availing hostel accommodation will be charged to cover tuition, course ware (in electronic form) working lunch and other facilities of the College including internet usage.
