ASCI Annual Course on Effective Land Acquisition, Resettlement & Rehabilitation (LARR), October 21-25, 2019

Background

Acquisition of land is presently carried out through various legislations in India; the central legislation, Right to Fair Compensation and Transparency in Land Acquisition, Rehabilitation and Resettlement Act (RFCTLARR), 2013 that replaced the colonial Land Acquisition Act, 1894 from 1st January, 2014; sector specific legislations like Coal Bearing Areas Acquisition and Development Act, 1957; National Highways Act, 1956, Railways Amendment Act, 2008 and various state specific legislations. Though processes vary in these legislations, the compensation and R & R norms specified in the RFCTLARR Act, 2013 is extended to these legislations. The 2013 Act provides that state governments can enact any law/policy to enhance or add the entitlements enumerated under the Act which confers higher compensation and R&R. Perception of potential delay in acquisition of land through formal mechanisms of land acquisition have also paved way to the emergence of alternative land assembly mechanisms. Some of the important alternatives that have emerged include land pooling, land purchase and land lease. State governments like Telangana, Madhya Pradesh, Uttar Pradesh, West Bengal, Maharashtra, Karnataka, Orissa and Chhattisgarh have framed land purchase policies and are purchasing land from the landowners. The State Governments of Telangana, Gujarat, Telangana, Haryana, Jharkhand, Maharashtra have received Presidential assent for their RFCTLARR (Amendment) Acts. The High Courts have passed judgments regarding the legality of some of these alternate mechanisms.

About the Course

Lack of awareness about important land acquisition case laws have been resulting in recurring mistakes with manifold financial implications for the requiring/acquiring bodies. These valuable case laws relate to market value determination, compensation standards, publication/notification procedures, possession requirements, role of requiring bodies, interest payments etc. The ASCI Annual Course on Effective Land Acquisition, Resettlement & Rehabilitation (LARR) Course, 2019 will have exclusive focus on these case laws. There are also several national/international developments that merit the attention of all acquiring/requiring bodies dealing with land and R & R-the implementation experience of the RFCTLARR Act, 2013 and alternative land assembly measures (land acquisition, pooling and purchase); the interpretation and implementation of R & R provisions in the 2013 Act in diverse projects; addressing issues relating to forest land diversion and monetization of individual and community rights; due diligence measures for effective award enquiry; steps to ensure robust resettlement planning etc. The much appreciated *ASCI Annual Course on Effective LARR* comprehensively discusses all the above. Also, in the light of the implementation of the new land acquisition law/alternative land assembly mechanisms, the program aims at providing a roadmap for time-bound and efficient land assembly.

CMLARR, ASCI, Hyderabad

Administrative Staff College of India (ASCI) was established at Hyderabad on 18 May, 1956 at the initiative of the government and the corporate sector. The College was established on the lines of the Administrative Staff College at Henley-on-Thames in England. The ASCI main campus at Bella Vista, Hyderabad is the erstwhile palace of the Prince of Berar. In 1956, the first Court of Governors (CoG) was constituted under the Chairmanship of Dr. John Mathai, the former Union Finance Minister. General Shrinagesh, on retiring as Army Chief, was the first Principal of ASCI. The academic activities started on 6 December, 1957. The Value statement of ASCI (as per Rig Veda hymn) is, "Let us be together, let us interact together, and may our minds comprehend together".

India has accumulated vast experience in management of Land Acquisition, Resettlement and Rehabilitation (LARR). There was a long felt need for a Regional Centre for capacity building and research in management of LARR in the region. Recognizing the wealth of experience in both operations and policy development in India and ASCI's experience in LARR capacity building interventions, a World Bank-AusAID supported Regional South-South Learning Hub called the **Centre for Excellence in Management of Land Acquisition, Resettlement and Rehabilitation (CMLARR)** was established at ASCI.
