Objectives

- Enhance participant's understanding of business administration principles and practices.
- Develop management skills required for the effective leadership in civilian organizations.
- Provide insights into the job market and equip participants with tools for a successful career transition.
- Foster a network of like-minded individuals and experts in the civilian sector.

Programme design

The programme offers various courses to strengthen the business management and administration skills of the participants.

Overview of Business Administration and Management skills

The module covers the introduction of business administration, various theories involved in business & organizational administration, stages & evolution of public administration. Key topics include Project management, overview of labor laws, economic environment, labor laws in project management, Artificial Intelligence & data analysis, overview of human resources management & organizational behaviour. The module emphasizes on providing an overview on the contemporary issues, challenges and solutions in the domain of business management and administration.

Human Resource Management & Negotiations

The module covers the various theories involved in Human resources management & Negotiations. Key topics include Introduction to HRM, People management, HRM planning, Negotiations, Performance management & improvement, Compensation, Job analysis and design, Training management, Recruitment & Selection. The module emphasizes on HRM principles, strategic people management, workforce planning, negotiation techniques, and key HR functions that contribute to organizational success.

Leadership in Organizational Administration

The module covers the various theories involved in Leadership in Organizational administration. Key topics include Self-awareness & Individual differences, Counseling, Leadership in Organizational administration, Emotional Intelligence, Dark leadership, Positive leadership, Team Building, Change management. The module aims to develop leadership competencies in organizational settings by focusing on interactive learning, case studies, and practical exercises, psychometric assessments and simulation-based exercises.

Strategic Management

The module covers the various theories involved in Leadership in Organizational administration. Key topics include, Introduction to Strategic Management, Principles of Management, Porter's five forces model – strategy, Corporate level strategy, Strategic directions, Ansoff matrix, Portfolio analysis(2 sessions), Case study, Problem solving – Strategic management. strategic management theories and frameworks relevant to leadership in organizational administration. It combines conceptual learning with case studies and problemsolving exercises to develop strategic thinking and decision-making skills.

Procurement Management

The module covers various topics that include, Procurement management: An Introduction, Overview of the Procurement Manual, Supply Chain Management, Procurement in the Global Private sector. This module provides an understanding of procurement management principles, policies, and best practices, focusing on supply chain efficiency and procurement.

Data Analytics & Information Technology

The module covers various topics that include, Introduction to contemporary technology, Introduction to Tableau, Introduction to Power-BI, Advance Business Intelligence, Big data analytics. This module provides an in-depth understanding of modern technological advancements and their application in business intelligence (BI) and data analytics for data- driven decision-making.

Financial Management

The module covers various topics including, Introduction to Financial management, Cash Budgeting(1 session), Financial projections – Profit analysis(1 session), Capital structuring – Cost of capital, Working capital – Project cost, Project Finance – Techniques & Assessment, Working Capital, Working Capital secrets – Hidden keys to Business success, Wealth management strategies. This module aims to equip participants with the knowledge and skills required to make informed financial decisions, optimize resource allocation, and enhance financial sustainability in organizations.

Civilian Job Market Insights

The module covers various topics that include, Transition to civilian life, Exploring career opportunities, Linked-in Optimization, Resume Building and Interview Skills, Industry Research, Entrepreneurship Opportunities. This module is designed to help tri-service officers transition smoothly into the corporate world or entrepreneurial ventures. It covers career planning, personal branding, networking strategies, industry research, and business opportunities to ensure a successful second career.

Strategic Finance

The module covers, Overview of Strategic Finance, Capital allocation & Investment decisions, Financial planning & Forecasting, Financial performance metrics & KPIs, Corporate valuation & value creation. This module is designed to equip participants with the knowledge and analytical skills required to make strategic financial decisions that enhance business performance, optimize capital allocation, and maximize corporate value.

Marketing Management

The module covers, Market research & consumer insights, Brand management & positioning, Digital marketing strategy, Product life cycle management, Pricing strategies & Revenue optimization, Customer relationship management & Loyalty programs, Integrated Marketing communications Marketing analytics & ROI. This module aims to provide participants with a comprehensive understanding of marketing principles and strategies to enhance brand value, customer engagement, and business growth.

Corporate Governance

Participants will explore governance frameworks, board dynamics, and strategic decision- making to ensure accountability through Understanding Corporate Governance, Frameworks of Corporate Governance, Board Governance, Strategic leadership, Financial stewardship & accountability, Leading towards higher standards. This module aims to develop a deep understanding of corporate governance as a foundation for ethical leadership, financial integrity, and sustainable business success.

Managerial Economics

The module covers, Demand & Supply, Demand & Supply – practical applications, Production & cost estimation, Market structure – different types of markets, Influence of externalities – Micro economics, Brief background of Macroeconomics. This module provides an understanding of fundamental economic principles that influence business decision-making, market dynamics, and policy frameworks.

Project Management

The module covers, Project planning & scheduling, Risk Management, Project cost management & Budgeting, Resource allocation & team management, Quality management, Monitoring & Evaluation. This module aims to equip participants with practical project management skills to effectively plan, execute, monitor, and control projects while optimizing resources and mitigating risks.

Legal Aspects of Business

The module covers, Introduction to Business laws, Business structures & Legal entities, Contract law & Business agreements, Consumer protection law, Taxation laws & Financial compliance. This module is designed to provide participants with a comprehensive understanding of legal principles and regulatory frameworks governing businesses.

Artificial Intelligence & Business Decision Making

The module covers, AI applications in Project management, AI applications in marketing management, AI applications in HRM, AI applications in Financial management, AI applications in strategic management, AI applications in supply chain management, AI applications in customer relationship management. This module aims to equip participants with a deep understanding of AI-driven innovations in various management functions, enabling them to enhance efficiency, decision-making, and competitive advantage.

Statistics for Management
