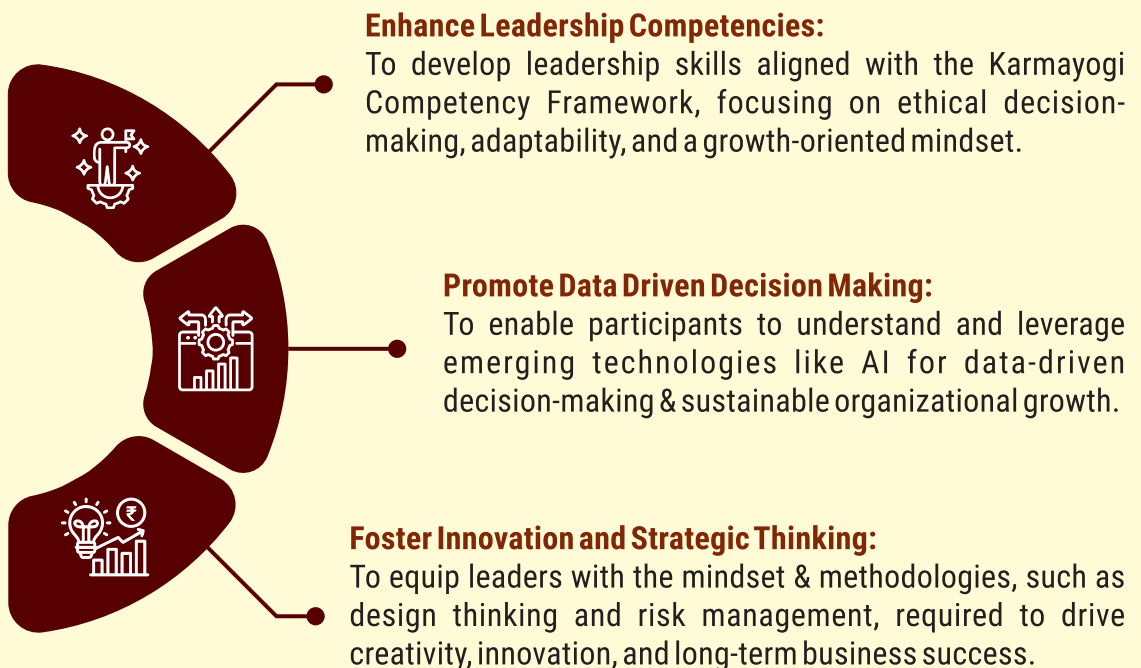

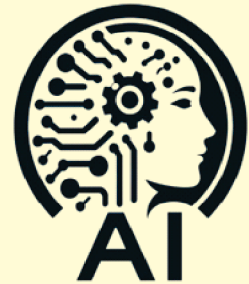

While we recommend the structure for 4 days of the Programme, 5th day can be customised for organisations based on their nature of work and sector.

Andragogy

The training methodology combines a mix of interactive and participatory learning techniques to ensure engagement and effectiveness. **Interactive lectures** will be used to introduce key concepts and frameworks, followed by **case studies** that provide real-world examples and allow participants to analyze and apply concepts in a practical context. **Group discussions** will encourage collaborative learning, enabling participants to share perspectives, challenge assumptions, and deepen their understanding.

Role plays and simulations will be conducted to immerse participants in real-life scenarios where they can practice and refine their skills in a safe environment. Finally, **hands-on training on AI tools** will offer a practical approach, allowing participants to directly apply their learning through activities and exercises tailored to their specific challenges.



Faculty

In addition to the College faculty, eminent practitioners from industry with expertise in leadership, management, data analytics, and cybersecurity will share their practical experiences with the participants.

Venue

The Programme will be conducted in the picturesque Hyderabad campus of ASCI.

Programme Date

To be decided based on mutual convenience.

Programme Fee

The programme fee for on-campus programme for 5 days (in the campus of ASCI) is Rs. 75,000/- per participant for a minimum of 20 participants. The fee includes professional fee, boarding and lodging, provision for courseware (in electronic form) and a kit (bag, pen, pad, etc.) for all participants. A Certificate of Participation will also be given to all participants. Participants over and above 20 will be charged on a pro-rata basis. Taxes, as applicable (currently a GST of 18%) will have to be paid by the client in addition to the programme fee.
